What is a Comprehensive Plan?

The Comprehensive Plan is DWG's most important document regarding future growth, development, and change. The Comprehensive Plan is the basis for land development regulations (Zoning and Subdivision Ordinances) and decisions (rezonings, special exception and use permits), capital improvements (schools, parks, libraries), transportation, environmental and historic resource protection initiatives. Texas towns, cities, and counties are not required to adopt a Comprehensive Plan; however, once adopted, it must follow it when making zoning decisions.
