DWG City Limits

DWG's boundaries have fluctuated through a series of annexations and deannexations during its 75 years. The original outline of the almost 600 acres of the Dalworthington Gardens Homestead Association can be seen outlined in red on the 1950s aerial map in the foyer at city hall. These boundaries didn't change until the Town of DWG was incorporated in 1949. Additional annexations and deannexations occurred in 1952, 1957, 1964, 1966, 1971, 1982 and 1983 when the city limits of DWG became what we know them today.

When the town of DWG incorporated, the original homestead association except for much of block 2 became the new town. During the 50s that excluded portion and most of what now makes up the northern portion of our city was annexed. The southern portions of our city seem to have been added in the 60s, with a couple of small additions to the western side of the city of DWG coming in the 80's.

With a bit more investigation, the DWG Historic Committee hopes to have a map ready in time to display at the celebration weekend that shows the changes in DWG's boundaries over time.

A fee of 5% of the total amount for this service will be added to the total amount charged. Credit Cards accepted include: Discover, Mastercard, Visa, and American Express.

REMINDER:

No watering from 10:00 A.M. - 6:00 P.M. except for hand watering and the use of soaker hoses, this is year round. Residents with sprinkler and irrigation systems found watering during these hours will be fined. There is an exemption for sodding, but the exemption must be applied for and approved by the city. It is unlawful for any person to irrigate, water, or cause or permit the irrigation or watering of any lawn or landscape between the hours of 10:00 A.M. and 6:00 P.M.
