If you have an emergency always call 9-1-1, or if you need assistance and it is not an emergency, you may call dispatch at 817-275-1234 ext. 1 for immediate assistance. Please do not use any social media sites as means to attempt to report emergencies.

A quick reminder that if you and your family are traveling over the next several months, we encourage our residents to fill out a house watch form if you would like extra patrols done while you are gone. You can obtain this form on our City website, or you may come by our station and pick one up at the dispatch window that is staffed 24/7.

We are still working on compiling a list of all homes and businesses located in DWG that have exterior cameras or door bell camera systems. Our list will be implemented into our GIS system to assist our detectives in gathering information while conducting investigations. If you would like to participate, please contact Lt. We would really appreciate everyone's help in this, as we would like this program to be highly beneficial for all of our residents in the near future.

HELP STOP ILLEGAL DUMPING AT THE BACK OF PAPPY ELKINS LAKE

Dumping brush and trash at the west-end of Elkins Drive is illegal and punishable by fine. This area (see picture below) is actually park property. City staff will be making arrangements to remove all city material and brush currently on location. Residents have options for brush removal:

- Call Republic Services at (817) 317-2000 to ask for a quote for loose brush removal.
- Bundle limbs and brush in 4-foot lengths and bind with string or wire and set them out for regular Tuesday/Friday pickups.
- Take your loose brush to Living Earth in Arlington for a nominal fee. <https://livingearth.net/recycling/>



The City will hold a clean-up day this fall. Watch for details.

Cruiser's availability in order to schedule city clean-up days. HHW Solutions picks up household hazardous waste once a month. To schedule your July 25 pickup, go to <http://hhwsolutions.com/> or call (972) 440-2040.

Our first pickup of household hazardous waste by HHW Solutions is July 25. During the last city-wide clean-up day, many citizens missed or did not know about the two-hour window that the Ft. Worth Crud Cruiser was on site. Staff also has to work around the Crud
